RANGE CONDITIONS – SAPOL ORQ

Approval of the grounds of a shooting club are subject to conditions pursuant to Part 9, Division 1 of the *Firearms Regulations 2017*.

This special range approval for the club noted below is subject to the following additional conditions: -

- The range certificate, range conditions document, and range standing orders document must be displayed in a prominent place at your club whenever shooting activities are taking place.

General range conditions

- Maximum rifle ammunition nature not to exceed 7.62 x 51mm NATO ball
- The section of range 5 identified for SAPOL ORQ use shall be known as range 5a.

Range 5a only

- The range may be used for static standing and moving pistol shooting (.40 calibre) – restricted to no greater than 10m distance only.
- The range may be used for static standing rifle (up to .308i) shooting – restricted to no greater than 10m distance only.
- The range may be used for tactical movement for static standing shotgun (12g buckshot / sold) shooting – restricted to no greater than 20m distance only.
- Target centre height must be set at 1.4m for pistol and rifle shooting.
- Target must be placed no more than 1m from the base of the backstop for all serials / weapons.
- Targets for shotgun training must be placed in the centre of the backstop.
- Targets to be paper-based and supported by wooden stands.
- No person is to be present forward of the 150-metre line (on the SSAA Moonta 200-metre range) while rifle or shotgun disciplines are being conducted.

- A range log to be used to record the following:
 - Details of Range Officer in charge
 - That Range Standing Orders and conditions sighted
 - Discipline being completed and number of shooters on the range
 - Safety checks being completed pre-post live firing
 - Number of rounds fired (provided to SSAA Moonta for overall range maintenance)
